I am delighted with the results of this year's Pascal, Cayley, and Fermat competitions. Under the leadership of the Contest Committee co-chairs Peter Crippin and Ian VanderBurgh we have made the early and middle parts of the papers more accessible to a greater number of participants. This resulted in the average scores being higher than at any time in the past decade. Some people have suggested that this has made the contests "too easy" and on which it is "not a challenge to score perfect". The number of perfect scores in this year's contests were 26 in Pascal, 23 in Cayley, and 26 in Fermat. This represents less than 0.2% of all contestants, which is not too high a rate. I applaud the contest committee for their efforts and have urged them to continue in this style.

Also to be applauded are the many teachers who registered, prepared, and supervised the thousands of students who participated in these contests. Without the time, energy, and organization of these teachers there would be no competitors, and thus no competition.

Finally, I thank everyone for their participation in the contests this year, my first as Director following the retirement of Ron Scoins. I look forward to continuing in support of your efforts on behalf of students.

Je suis très satisfait des résultats de l'édition 2002 des concours Pascal, Cayley et Fermat organisée par les coprésidents du comité des concours, Peter Crippin et Ian VanderBurgh. Cette année, on a rendu les parties introductive et intermédiaire des concours accessibles à un plus grand nombre de participants. Résultat : les notes moyennes sont les plus élevées depuis dix ans. On a laissé entendre que cette accessibilité accrue avait diminué le niveau de difficultés des concours et augmenté le nombre de notes parfaites. En réalité, moins de 0,2% des participants ont obtenu une note parfaite (soit 26 pour le concours Pascal, 23 pour le concours Cayley et 26 pour le concours Fermat), ce qui est tout à fait acceptable.
