



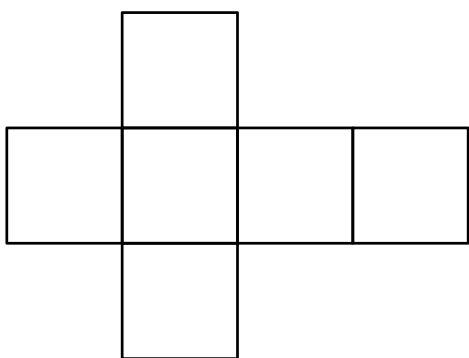

Problem A

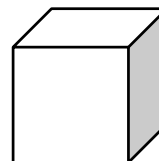
Nancy's Nets
